Materials

- Scavenger Hunt Grid
Print the record sheets or write the numbers 1–20 on paper.
- Something to write with (pen, pencil, crayon, or marker)
- A curious mind
- Extra paper for drawings (optional)

Skills

This game helps us practice:

- Identifying numerals to 20
- Counting to 20
- Identifying flat and solid shapes
- Solving addition and subtraction expressions within 10
- Comparing measurable attributes of objects







How to Play

- If your child can't find something, remind them that it's okay to make or draw it.







Change It Up

- Make your own math scavenger hunt! Help your family find the items.





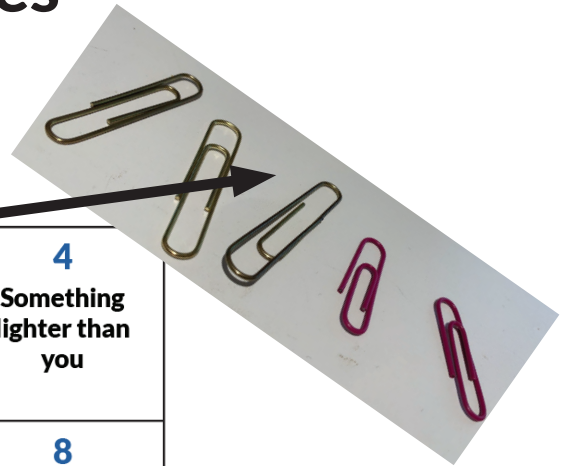


